He holds a Bachelor of Church Music degree from St. Olaf College, a Master of Music degree from Yale University and a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Oklahoma. His dissertation and current research focus is on the role of the pipe organ in American Freemasonry during the first half of the twentieth century.

In addition to his position at Luther Memorial, Andrew serves as the Editor-at-Large of *The Diapason*, one of the oldest and largest American journals devoted to organ, harpsichord, and church music. Andrew is active in the American Guild of Organists, having served as Dean of the Oklahoma City chapter and currently serving a term as Dean of the Madison, WI chapter.
