

A native of Wisconsin, David Bohn received degrees in composition from the University of Wisconsin, University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, and the University of Illinois. His primary composition teachers were Joel Naumann, Yehuda Yannay, and William Brooks.

An avid performer of contemporary music, Dr. Bohn has premiered over 90 new compositions since 2013; his most recent new music project is "The Daniel Blitz Clavichord Project", 46 pieces he recorded and posted on YouTube in honor of the clavichord his uncle built, and in the fall will be recording the selected pieces from the 100-note Toy Piano Project. He currently resides in West Allis, Wisconsin, and is organist and choir director for St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church in West Milwaukee.

He is President of the Wisconsin Alliance for Composers, Vice President of the Wisconsin Chapter of the Organ Historical Society, and just finished his third term the board for the Milwaukee Chapter of the American Guild of Organists; he also edits the newsletter for the Wisconsin OHS.
